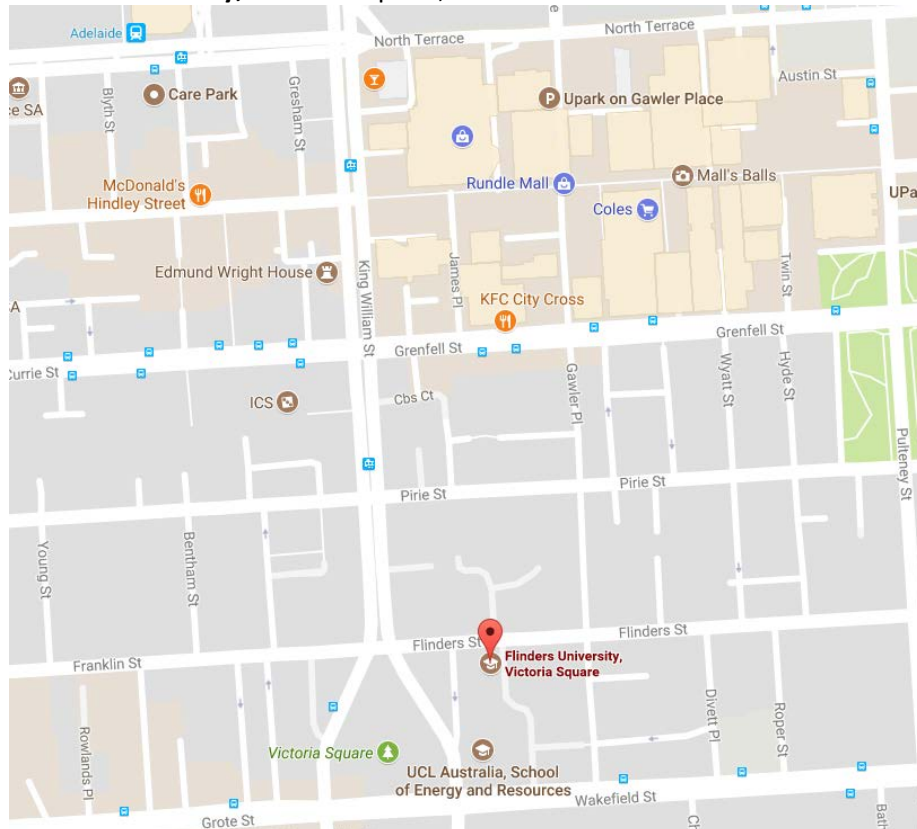

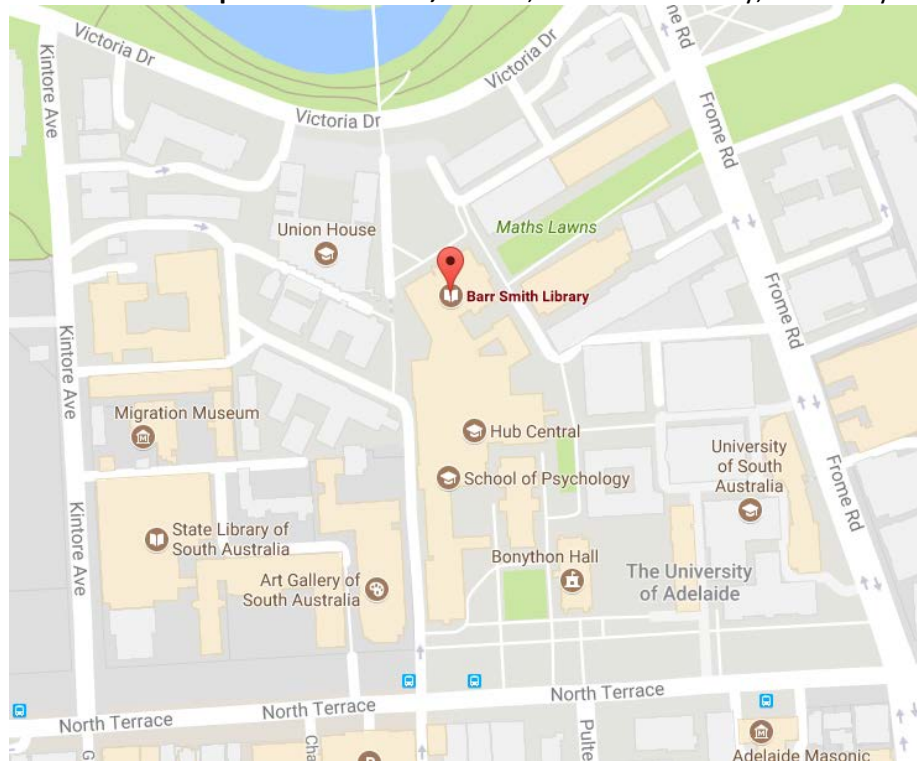

## Flinders University, Victoria Square, Room 2 Level 1

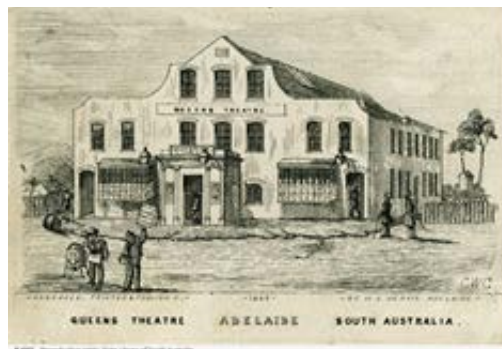
